The Texas Narcotic Officers' Association in conjunction with the DEA-Houston FO and the Regional Counterdrug Training Academy (RCTA) will sponsor a 16-hour hour class entitled "CONTROLLED DELIVERIES" in Garland, Texas. TCOLE credit will be given for this course.

Check in will begin at 0730 hours and the class will start promptly at 0800 hours on Monday, September 12, 2016, at the Garland Police Department, 1891 Forest Lane, Garland, Texas 75042.

COURSE TOPICS: • Drugs • Currency • Identify co-conspirators • Apply Risk Assessment • Logistics • Take Downs.

This 2-day course is designed specifically for law enforcement officers and supervisory personnel who have interdiction, patrol, or narcotics investigation responsibilities. The course is designed to teach officers how to utilize sophisticated techniques to develop investigations, identify co-conspirators, and to make additional seizures and arrests. Students will also learn how to apply a risk assessment to determine the feasibility of conducting a controlled a delivery and will participate in practical exercises in operational planning and source debriefings.

The instructor for this course will be Retired DEA Supervisory Special Agent Arthur Richards.

This is a tuition **FREE** course and is open to all law enforcement personnel and US Military. To register you must have an agency point of contact register your agency with RCTA who will then be responsible for registering individual agency officers for the course. **Please follow the below instructions to register your agency's POC.**
