This two-day course is designed for Law Enforcement professionals tasked with the identification, disruption and dismantling of large scale trafficking organizations and has been designed based on current trends and extreme violence occurring within the border regions of Mexico and the United States. It is imperative that we arm investigators with a basic understanding of Drug Cartels and how they operate. During this course, students will receive training to include the history, components, influence, and methods of operation in use by drug cartels today. The training will also provide investigators with basic tools that can be used to gather intelligence in furtherance of criminal investigations as they relate to drug cartels.

"Mexican Cartels and Their Violence" training will include, but not be limited to: • Introduction to Drug Cartels • Drug Cartels Influence on Government • Cartel Membership • Methods of Operation • Cartels at War and Why • Cartel Enforcement Components • Intelligence Exploitation for law Enforcement.
