The Texas Narcotic Officers' Association East Region will host a 2-Day / 16 hour training course titled "TACTICAL CARBINE — LEVEL 1" in Richmond, Texas. This course is specially designed for the Female Patrol Officer / Operator. This course will be *limited to 20 students* so reserve your spot today!

Registration is open and TCOLE hours will be given. Check in will begin at 0730 hours and the course will start promptly at 0800 hours on Tuesday, January 16, 2018, at the Richmond Police Department.

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course will address the effective use of the Tactical Police Carbine with emphasis on quick and accurate shooting at close to intermediate ranges.

Students will undergo a classroom instruction on the basic carbine nomenclature and carbine setup (slings, optics, lights). There will be a thorough review of your support equipment and gear, proper iron sight and optics grouping and range safety rules.

You will then move to the range where you will spend a full 14-hours becoming one with your carbine. We expect you to come to this class with basic iron sights and red dot type optics and your carbine at least "On Paper" with a 50-yard "Zero". We will confirm your "Zero" immediately after the classroom portion.

The class will then progress into shooting fundamentals, breathing, supination grip, and shooting positions (prone, sitting, kneeling, squatting, and standing). We will move quickly into close range shooting drills where we will focus on accuracy, multiple targets and timed reaction drills. We will cover reloading drills and weapon malfunctions to efficiently get your carbine back into the fight. This will also include weapon transition drills and communication. We will then focus on basic shooting on the move and deploying your carbine from your patrol vehicle.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:

500 rounds rifle / 150 rounds pistol • Minimum of 3 magazines rifle/pistol • Spare rifle magazine carrier (couplers are allowed) •Rifle sling • Hearing / Eye protection • Duty belt, holster, & Body armor • Cleaning kit with gun oil • Optional equipment: Weather related clothing (rain gear) • Hat • Tactical gloves • Knee pads • Dump pouch

TUITION:

The fee for this course is \$100.00. <u>Includes lunch on the second day and a free entry</u> to the East Region's Tactical 3-Gun Challenge being held on January 20, 2018. You do not have to be a member of TNOA to register for this course.
