The Texas Narcotic Officers' Association East Region along with the DEA Houston Field Office and the Brazoria County Sheriff's Office will host a 40-hour (5-day) training course entitled "**ADVANCED NARCOTICS INVESTIGATIONS**" provided by the Regional Counterdrug Training Academy (RCTA) in Angleton, Texas. Registration is **OPEN** through RCTA. TCOLE hours will be reported by the Brazoria County Sheriff's Office Training Unit.

Check in will begin at 0715 hours and the course will start promptly at 0800 hours on Monday, May 6, 2019.

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course enhances the ability of the investigator so they can successfully conduct a major investigation. The course also develops the whole of government concept, legally acquired court order electronic surveillances and intercepts (T-3) and why they should coordinate with Federal, State, and local agencies as well as prosecutors in order to ensure successful prosecutions.

The course also covers investigations of narco-terrorism and transnational organized crime (TOC) activities. The techniques learned in this course are designed to disrupt the flow of precursor chemicals, materials and illicit finance activities that support illegal drug production. Additionally time will be spent on Darkweb and Crypto currency investigations. The course will culminate with a hands-on practical exercise.

Students are required to attend all 5-days to receive the full 40-hours TCOLE credit.
